Dear Mr Wood,

As National Statistician and Chief Executive of the UK Statistics Authority, I am replying to your Parliamentary Question asking what estimate has been made of the number of deaths attributable to the inhalation of nitrous oxide (67408).

Table 1 provides the number of drug-related deaths where nitrous oxide was mentioned on the death certificate in England and Wales, for deaths registered between 2011 and 2015.

These figures are taken from our drug-related deaths database, which includes accidents and suicides involving drug poisonings, as well as deaths from drug abuse and drug dependence (see Box 1). Drug related deaths involve a broad spectrum of substances, including legal and illegal drugs, prescription-type drugs (either prescribed to the individual or obtained by other means) and over-the-counter medications.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>3</sup> Figures are for deaths registered, rather than deaths occurring, in each calendar year. Due to the length of time it takes to complete a coroner's inquest, it can take months or even years for a drug-related death to be registered.
